## Assembling the Printer

Confirm the  $\circ$  (OFF)

Remove the printer cover

Remove the paper tension unit

Slide the print head to the middle of the printer by hand

Pull the ribbon guide until it is out of the cartridge

Tense

Slide the ribbon guide into the print head until it clicks in place

### **Caution:**

- The ribbon should not be twisted or creased.
- When inserting the ribbon guide, press firmly until it clicks.

Reinstall the paper tension unit

Replace the printer cover and lowering the cover into place

- The interface cable connectors have only one correct orientation. Make sure the orientation of the connector is correct before inserting it into the appropriate port.



### For Windows 7 users



The printer driver in the printer software CD-ROM included with this printer is not compatible with Windows 7. Use the driver included in Windows 7. Perform the following operations to install the driver included in Windows 7.

#### To install the driver (use the driver included with the operating system)

1. Make sure both the printer and your computer are turned off, then connect the printer and computer.
2. Turn on the printer.
3. Turn your computer on and start Windows 7.
4. The printer is detected and the driver included in Windows 7 is installed automatically.

**Note:**

## Important Safety Instructions

**7** Read all of these safety instructions before using the printer. In addition, follow all warnings and instructions marked on the printer itself.

#### Caution:

Be sure the AC power cord meets the relevant local safety standards.

- Use only the type of power source indicated on the printer's label.
- Connect all equipment to properly grounded power outlets.
- Do not use a damaged or frayed power cord.
- If you use an extension cord with the printer, make sure the total ampere rating of all devices plugged into the extension cord does not exceed the cord's ampere rating. Also, make sure the total ampere of all devices plugged into the wall outlet does not exceed the wall outlet's ampere rating.
- Unplug the printer before cleaning it, and always clean it with a piece of damp cloth only.
- Do not spill liquid onto the printer.
- Except as specifically explained in this guide, do not attempt to service the printer yourself.
- Unplug the printer and refer servicing to qualified service personnel under the following conditions:
  - i. If the power cord or plug is damaged.
  - ii. If liquid has entered the printer.
  - iii. If the printer has been dropped or the cabinet damaged.
  - iv. If the printer does not operate normally or exhibits a distinct change in performance.

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
