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
## **1** Safety Instructions

## Laser Printer Precautions

This printer uses laser technology. The following list of precautions applies whenever you open the printer cover. Even if you are familiar with other types of printers, be sure to follow these precautions carefully to ensure safe, efficient operation.


Do not touch the areas specified on the caution labels inside cover A. If the printer has been in use, these areas can be very hot.





- Do not touch the components inside the printer unless instructed to do so in this guide.
- □ Never force the printer's components into place. Although the printer is designed to be sturdy, rough handling can damage it.
- Do not turn the cartridge upside down or stand it on its sides.

Protect the light-sensitive drum from exposure to light. Avoid exposing the Imaging Cartridge to room light any longer than necessary. Do not open the drum's protective cover. Overexposing the drum may cause abnormally dark or light areas to appear on the printed page and reduce the service life of the drum.



- □ When handling the cartridge, always set it on a clean, smooth surface.
- □ Do not attempt to modify or take apart the cartridge. It cannot be refilled.
- Do not touch the toner and avoid all contact with your eyes.
- □ Wait for at least one hour before using a cartridge after moving it from a cool to a warm environment.



#### Warning:

Do not dispose of used Imaging Cartridges in fire, as they can explode and cause injury. Dispose of them according to local regulations. To get the best print quality, do not store the Imaging Cartridge in an area subject to direct sunlight, dust, salty air, or corrosive gasses (such as ammonia). Avoid locations subject to high temperatures, humidity, or abrupt changes in temperature or humidity. Also, be sure to keep the consumable components out of the reach of children.

## Important Safety Instructions

Read all of these instructions before operating your printer.

- □ Follow all warnings and instructions marked on the printer.
- **U**nplug the printer from the wall outlet before cleaning.
- □ Use a damp cloth for cleaning and do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners.
- Do not use this printer near water.
- Do not place the printer on an unstable cart, stand, or table.
- □ Slots and openings in the cabinet and the back or bottom are provided for ventilation. Do not block or cover them. Do not put the printer on a bed, sofa, rug, or other similar surface or in an enclosure unless proper ventilation is provided.

- □ Use the type of power source indicated on the label. If you are not sure of the type of power available, consult your dealer or local power company.
- □ If you are unable to insert the plug into the outlet, contact your electrician to have your outlet repaired or replaced.


## Installing the optional Large Capacity Paper Unit

We recommend installing the Large Capacity Paper Unit when setting up the printer. If you do not install the Large Capacity Paper Unit, proceed to "Installing the Imaging Cartridge" on page 13.

Follow these instructions to install the Large Capacity Paper Unit.

## Attaching the Large Capacity Paper Unit

1. Open the box with the Large Capacity Paper Unit. Cut the tape that holds the cardboard inserts.




2. Remove the inserts and all other protective materials inside the box. Make sure the contents of the package match the items on the included document.



*Remove the packaging materials from the unit and store them for future use.* 


3. Carefully lift the Large Capacity Paper Unit out of the box with two or more people, and place it near the printer.



4. Lock the casters at the bottom of the unit by pushing their levers down.



5. At the back of the unit, push the power cable into the slot.





6. Carefully lift the printer with two or more people.



## Caution:

- The printer weighs about 50 kg (110 lb); always lift it with two or more people.
- **Grasp** the printer at the locations indicated below.







7. Align each of the printer's corners with those of the unit, then lower the printer until it rests securely on the unit.




8. Make sure all corners of the printer fit firmly onto the unit.




## Preparing the Cassettes

1. Pull out lower cassette 2 as far as it will go. Then lift it up slightly, and completely remove it.




2. Pull out lower cassette 3. Take out and open the included package of metal fittings and screws.


3. Attach the two metal fittings with the screws as shown below. Note that the shapes of the two fittings are different.




- 4. Push cassette 3 back into the unit, then replace cassette 2.
- 5. Pull out cassette 4 and remove the protective materials inside.



6. Pull out lower cassette 5 and remove the protective materials inside.



7. Plug the cable from the Large Capacity Paper Unit into the appropriate connector at the back of the printer.



Make sure the cables connecting the options to the printer are connected securely.

## Installing the Imaging Cartridge




#### Caution:


- Do not turn the Imaging Cartridge upside down after the protective seal has been removed as this causes the toner to spill.
- Do not open the drum's protective cover and avoid exposing the Imaging Cartridge to room light any longer than necessary. Overexposing the cartridge may cause abnormally dark or light areas to appear on the printed page and reduce the life of the cartridge.
- □ We recommend the use of genuine EPSON Imaging Cartridges. Other products not manufactured by EPSON may cause damage to your printer not covered by EPSON's warranties.




1. While holding the Imaging Cartridge horizontally, gently shake it a few times to distribute the toner evenly.




2. Remove the attached sheet.




3. Open cover A by pulling the latch.



4. Open the cover on the front of the printer.




5. Holding the grip and tab on the Imaging Cartridge, insert the cartridge into the printer until it is fitted securely.




#### Note:

*Make sure the tab is pushed down and flush with the Imaging Cartridge. Otherwise, you cannot close the front cover or cover A.* 



6. Slowly pull the clear seal all the way out with firm, even force.







#### Caution:

- Be sure you install the Imaging Cartridge in the printer before removing the protective strip from the cartridge, as shown above. Otherwise, toner may spill from the cartridge.
- □ To avoid spilling toner, do not tilt the Imaging Cartridge.

7. Release the front cover; it closes automatically.



8. Close cover A by pushing it up and into the printer.





## Caution:

*Never transport the printer while the Imaging Cartridge is installed.* 

# **3** Installing the Options

You can install the memory module, ROM module, Hard Disk Drive, Interface Card, Duplex Unit, Face-up Tray, Multibin Unit, Finisher Stapler, and Envelope Feeder to the printer. See the installation instructions for the option you want to install.

Follow the instructions that correspond to the option you need to install.

## Memory Module

By installing a memory module in both open slots, you can increase printer memory up to 256 MB. You may want to add memory if you are having difficulty printing complex, graphicsintensive pages, using the Multibin Unit with the Duplex Unit, or if you regularly use numerous downloaded fonts.


You can purchase memory modules from various vendors. Be sure the memory module you purchase meets the following requirements.

DRAM type	Synchronous Dynamic RAM Double In-line Memory Module (SD RAM DIMM)
Memory size	16 MB, 32 MB, 64 MB, or 128 MB
Туре	168-pin type, 64 bit, with SPD
Access speed	66.66 MHz or higher (15 ns or less)
Height	Less than 40 mm

### Note:

The total printer memory is the standard 64 MB plus all installed DIMM. For example, if you install a 32 MB DIMM, the total printer memory is 96 MB. However, if you install two 128 MB DIMMs, the total available printer memory is still indicated as 256 MB though the installed memory is more than 256 MB.


- 1. Must sure the printer is off.
- 2. Open the top cover of the face-down tray with your fingers.




3. Loosen the two retaining screws and remove the plate.


*To avoid losing the retaining screws, do not remove them completely from the plate.* 




4. Slots for memory modules are located as shown below.




5. Pull the clips on each side of SLOT S1 outward.




6. Hold the memory module above SLOT S1 with the following orientation, then push it down into SLOT S1. Do not apply too much force.




7. On the right side, push the bottom corner of the memory module until the clip comes up.




8. On the left side, push the bottom corner of the memory module until the clip comes up to clamp the memory module securely.



- 9. To install another memory module in SLOT S2, repeat steps 3 through 8.
- 10. Replace the plate to its original position. Place the two outside tabs of the plate under the edge of the opening with the inside tabs on top of the edge.



11. Push the plate down into place.




- 12. Tighten the two screws that you loosened earlier.
- 13. Gently replace the top cover until it clicks shut.


## Hard Disk Drive

Follow the instructions below to install the Hard Disk Drive (C82377\*).

- 1. Follow steps 1 through 3 in "Memory Module" on page 18.
- 2. Align the three pins with the three holes, and the connector with the socket, then press the Hard Disk Drive down until the socket and connector are firmly connected.



3. Tighten the three screws with a screwdriver.




4. Follow steps 10 through 13 in "Memory Module" on page 18 to complete the procedure.


## **ROM Module**

Follow the instructions below to install the Adobe PostScript 3 Kit ROM module (C83235\*).

- 1. Follow steps 1 through 3 in "Memory Module" on page 18.
- 2. Slots for ROM modules are located as shown below.



3. Hold the ROM module oriented as shown below, then push the ROM module into SLOT A evenly until the button comes up.



4. Follow steps 10 through 13 in "Memory Module" on page 18 to complete the procedure.

## Interface Cards

This section describes how to install the optional interface cards listed below.

- □ To add a direct connection to an Ethernet system, use an optional Ethernet Card (C82362\*/C82363\*).
- □ To add a serial or parallel interface to your printer, use one of the following:

32 KB Serial interface card	C82307*
32 KB Parallel interface card	C82310 <b>*</b>

□ To add a direct connection to an IBM mini or mainframe system, use one of the following:

Coax interface card	C82314*
Twinax interface card	C82315 <b>*</b>

The coax and twinax connectors each contain a parallel interface. Since the printer's built-in parallel interface remains active, this gives you two parallel interfaces and a coax or twinax interface. Print jobs can be sent to any connection, and the printer automatically switches between the active ports.


The twinax interface is compatible with the following IBM systems: AS-400, System 36, 5251 (model 12), System 34, System 38, and 5294. When equipped with the EPSON twinax interface, the printer can be used in place of the following IBM system printers: 4210, 5224 (models 1 and 2), 5256 (models 1, 2, and 3), 3218 (non IPDS), 4214 (model 2), 5225 (models 1, 2, 3, and 4), and 5219 D01, D02.

The coax interface allows the printer to be connected to the following IBM control units and mainframe systems: 3174, 3276, 4274, and 3270.


□ To add a direct connection to your GPIB network, use the GPIB interface card (C82313\*).

Follow the instructions below to install an optional interface card.


- 1. Turn the printer so its back faces you.
- 2. Remove the two screws that secure the interface slot cover and remove the cover.



3. With the component side of the optional interface card facing up, slide the interface card into the grooves of the interface slot as shown below. Push the card firmly to lock it into place.



4. Secure the interface card with the two retaining screws.



## Duplex Unit


This unit allows you to print on both sides of paper automatically.

To install the unit, follow the instructions below.


1. Unpack the Duplex Unit and remove all protective materials.

## Caution:


*Open the inner tray and remove the protective insert; otherwise, the printer will not function properly.* 




- 2. Lift the Duplex Unit with both hands, and face the left side of the printer.
- 3. Lower the unit to insert the two matching hooks into the slots in the MP tray's holder. Attach the hooks to the corresponding mounting rods.




4. Attach the second hook on the right side to the rod until you hear a click.




5. Grasp the strap on the left side of the unit and insert the hook at the end of the strap into the slot as shown below.



6. Close the Duplex Unit until it clicks.



7. After removing the protective cover from the cord, plug the cord of the Duplex Unit into the appropriate connector at the back of the printer.




## Face-up Tray (without the Duplex Unit installed)


Installation procedures differ depending on whether the optional Duplex Unit is installed.

Follow the instructions below if you will not install the optional Duplex Unit on your printer.


- 1. Unpack the Face-up Tray and remove all protective materials. Make sure the contents of the package match the items on the Packing list.
- 2. Attach the metal bar with the static barrier to the printer as shown below.




3. Insert and tighten the two finger screws included with the Face-up Tray as shown below.




4. Attach the frame to the tray with the two remaining screws.



5. Hook the top edge of the Face-up Tray around the metal bar to attach the tray to the printer.




6. Lower the Face-up Tray.

To use the Face-up Tray, set Face-up Enable to On in the SelecType Setup menu after setting up and turning on the printer. See "Faceup Printing" in the Reference Guide. To temporarily remove the Face-up Tray, lift and tilt it upward.




# Face-up Tray (with the Duplex Unit installed)


Installation procedures differ depending on whether the optional Duplex Unit is installed.

Follow the instructions below if you will install both the Face-up Tray and the optional Duplex Unit.


- 1. Unpack the Face-up Tray and remove all protective materials. Make sure the contents of the package match the items on the packing list.
- 2. Push the plate on the optional Duplex Unit in six locations to detach it. Then remove the plate.




3. Attach the cover to the printer using the two finger screws included with the Face-up Tray.




4. Holding the hook as shown below, attach it to the printer by sliding it into the slot.



5. To attach the tray, hook the slots on both sides of the Face-up Tray to the corresponding pegs.




6. Lower the Face-up Tray.



#### Note:

- □ To use the Face-up Tray, set Face-up Enable to On in the SelecType Setup menu after setting up and turning on the printer. See "Face-up Printing" in the Reference Guide.
- □ You can open the DM cover without detaching the Face-up Tray. The tray remains angled to hold printed sheets as shown on the following page.




# Multibin Unit

This unit can be used as a mailbox, a sorter, a multiple sorter, or a large capacity stacker. To install the Multibin unit, follow the instructions below.

#### Note:


- **D** This unit cannot be installed at the same time as the Finisher Stapler.
- □ Install the memory module, ROM module and Hard Disk Drive before you install the Multibin Unit.
- □ The optional Large Capacity Paper Unit must be installed when attaching the optional Multibin Unit.

1. Open the box from the top. Without removing the Multibin Unit, remove all other parts and protective materials from the box. Make sure the contents of the package match the items on the included document.



### Installing the side brackets


- 1. Open the included box and take out the side bracket that fits on the right side of the Large Capacity Paper Unit (see illustration).
- 2. Align the two pins on the side bracket with the holes on the right side as shown below. Insert the pins into the Large Capacity Paper Unit, then lower the bracket until it is firmly attached.




- 3. Insert one of the included screws shown above into the hole in the side bracket and tighten.
- 4. Remove the protective cover from the remaining side bracket, then repeat steps 2 and 3 to install the side bracket to the left side of the printer.

#### Installing the top bracket

- 1. Remove the protective cover from the top bracket.
- 2. With the orientation shown below, insert the two legs of the top bracket into the side brackets and push down evenly on both sides until the bracket clicks into place.




3. Remove the protective material from the top pin.




## Installing the Multibin Unit


1. Pull away the four clips from the box, then lift the box up.



2. After you remove the box, the Multibin Unit remains on the floor as shown below. Remove the protective material just before installing the unit on the printer.



3. Grasp the Multibin Unit at the solid areas shown below.







#### Caution:

Do not support the unit at the areas marked with an X above (the latch on cover D and the end of the arm). Attempting this might damage the cover or the unit.


4. Lift the unit and align the pole on the Multibin Unit with the pole of the top bracket as shown below.




5. Lower the Multibin Unit until the plate on the Multibin Unit is slightly higher than the top of the pin on the top bracket.



6. Push the Multibin Unit horizontally into the pole on the top bracket as shown below.




7. Lower the Multibin Unit until the pin fits completely into the hole on the plate.




8. Make sure the bottom part of the unit is set above and parallel with the printer.

### Locking the Multibin Unit


1. Remove the protective tape as shown below.



2. Open cover D and detach the grip from the inside. To detach the grip, push the button near the side of the grip, lower the grip a little, then pull it away from the Multibin Unit.



3. Attach the grip on the opposite side of the Multibin Unit. To do this, align the grip's metal bracket with the slot in the top bracket, then insert the grip into the hollow on the side of the Multibin Unit. Push in until it clicks.





### After installing


1. Open cover D and remove all protective materials inside and outside the Multibin Unit.



2. Attach the sheet stopper by inserting its two ends into the holes on the top and bottom bin.



3. Plug the cord of the Multibin Unit into the appropriate connector on the back of the printer.



# Finisher Stapler

To install the Finisher Stapler to your printer, follow the instructions below.

#### Note:


- □ The Finisher Stapler cannot be installed at the same time as the Multibin Unit.
- □ The optional Large Capacity Paper Unit must be installed when attaching the optional Finisher Stapler.
- 1. Carefully open the box according to the instructions printed on it.
- 2. Remove the inserts and all other protective materials inside the box. Make sure the contents of the package match the items on the included document.


Store the packaging materials in case you want to ship the Finisher Stapler in the future.

### Installing the cover unit


1. Raise the cover unit flap.




2. Face the front of the printer and place the cover unit on the top left side of the printer. Make sure the lip on the side of the cover is positioned under the connecting edge of the printer, as shown below.



3. Align the connecting tabs on the cover unit with the corresponding slots on the edge of the printer as shown below. Then gently pull the cover towards the left side of the printer until it clicks into place.




4. Make sure the switch is exposed and parallel to the floor as shown below.




Preparing the brackets and guide rail


1. Make sure you install the bracket with the "V" shaped edge seal facing up.




2. Attach the bracket to the printer by inserting the two finger screws into the holes as shown and screwing them in.




3. Slide the guide rail under the center of the printer as far as it will go, as shown below. Make sure the guide rail is parallel to the front of the printer.




4. At the left side of the printer, align the bracket with the third hole from the front, lift it over the printer's plastic cover panel, and insert its tab into the hole.



5. At the right side of the printer, align the bracket with the third hole from the front and firmly push it upwards between the printer's plastic cover panel and frame until it clicks into place.




6. Hold the paper transport parallel to the ground and unfold the two brackets under the edge nearest to the printer by pulling on the tabs. Rotate the brackets into place by turning them down and to the side as shown and push them snugly against the retainers.




### Connecting the Finisher Stapler

1. Bring the Finisher Stapler towards the printer until its power cord and connector cable can easily reach the printer.




*Caution:* Be careful not to tip over the Finisher Stapler when moving it.

2. Fully extend the guide rail attached underneath the printer and align it with the guide rail slot under the Finisher Stapler. Make sure the guide rail is completely inserted into the guide rail slot under the Finisher Stapler and is aligned with the slot underneath the right side of the Finisher Stapler. 3. Pass the Finisher Stapler power cord behind the bracket and plug it into the printer as shown below.




4. Connect the Finisher Stapler connector cables to the rear of the printer as shown below.




5. Make sure the guide rail is firmly inserted into the guide rail slot at the base of the Finisher Stapler. Insert the finger screw into the hole at the end of the guide rail and hand tighten it as shown below.



6. Connect the Finisher Stapler with the printer by aligning the pins on the left-hand edge of the paper transport with the holes on the top edge of the cover unit, then lock the rear wheels on the Finisher Stapler.



7. Open the front cover of the Finisher Stapler and push the Staple Cartridge into the Finisher Stapler until the lever lifts up.




8. Close the front cover of the Finisher Stapler.


# Envelope Feeder

To install the Envelope Feeder, you must remove the MP tray first.

- 1. Unpack the Envelope Feeder and remove all protective materials.
- 2. Remove the MP tray by lifting it slightly and pulling it out toward you. The MP tray does not detach easily; use sufficient force to pull it away from the printer.




- 3. Hold the Envelope Feeder horizontally with both hands.
- 4. Push it straight to the MP tray's original position until it clicks firmly into place.



# **4** Testing and Connecting the Printer

# Plugging in the printer

1. Make sure the power switch on the top of the printer is turned off, as shown below.



2. Insert the power cord into the AC inlet at the back of the printer. Then plug the other end into a properly grounded outlet.



#### Caution:

Avoid using outlets that other appliances are plugged into.


• Only use an outlet that meets the power requirements for this printer.

# Testing the printer


To test whether the printer is set up correctly, print a status sheet. The status sheet contains information about the printer and the installed options, including the current settings. To print a status sheet, follow the steps below.

### Loading paper

1. Open the MP tray if it is closed against the body of the printer. Pull out the extension if necessary.



2. Fan a stack of A4 or Letter size paper and tap it on a flat surface to even its edges. With the printable side down, load the stack by inserting it all the way into the tray. Make sure the paper lies below the arrows on the paper guide. Adjust the guide to match the size of your paper.



### Printing a status sheet

1. Turn the power switch at the front of the printer on. The lights and the display messages are changed in the following order:

All lights come on once and then turn off. The display shows ROM check.

The display shows RAM check XXXMB, with the actual memory size of your printer, including the memory size of optional memory modules if installed, is displayed in place of XXX.

The display shows SelfTest, and then shows Warming Up. The On Line light comes on.

After about 60 seconds, the display shows Ready.

- 2. Press the Enter button. The display shows Status Sheet.
- 3. Press the Enter button again. The message on the display starts flashing and the printer starts printing the status sheet.
- 4. Check the following points in the printed status sheet:
  - □ The printer can print the status sheet clearly.
  - □ The information on the options installed to the printer is printed correctly. If you can find the installed option's name under Hardware Configurations title, it means that the printer can recognize the installed option properly.

#### Note:

□ The total printer memory is the standard 64 MB plus all installed DIMM. For example, if you install a 32 MB DIMM, the total printer memory is 96 MB.

- □ However, if you install two 128 MB DIMMs, the total available printer memory is still indicated as 256 MB though the installed memory is more than 256 MB.
- □ If the installed option's name is not listed on the status sheet, make sure the cables connecting the options to the printer are connected securely.
- □ For the Face-up Tray to be shown as an option on the status sheet, it must be enabled Face-up Enable set to On in the SelecType Setup menu. Then turn the power switch off/on or perform Reset all.
- □ If the printer cannot print the status sheet or you find any problem with the printing result of the status sheet, contact your dealer.

# Connecting to the computer

Though this printer is intended to be used on a network, you can use the parallel interface to connect the printer directly to a computer.




To connect the parallel interface, follow the steps below.

- 1. Make sure both the printer and the computer are off.
- 2. Connect the parallel cable to the parallel interface connector.

*Note: Use only a shielded, twisted-pair parallel cable.* 



3. Secure the connector by pushing the two wire clips together until they lock in place on both sides of the connector.



- 4. Connect the other end of the cable to your computer, and fasten it as required.
- 5. Turn on the printer, then turn on your computer.


